### The Lachtal is THE legendary skiing area

10 modern cableways and lifts take winter sports enthusiasts from an altitude of 1,600 m up to 2,222 m above sea level. Wonderful wide, sunny slopes and 10 km of challenging ski routes offer a perfect skiing experience.

**TIP:** Speed track and the "Grossa" downhill run!

Enjoy traditional flair with a romantic ski hut atmosphere at the Lachtal, which nestles in a beautifully pristine mountain world.

### Family benefits

- ▶ **Family bonus:** Only two children/young people pay when accompanied by at least one parent. Further children/young people ski for free! (ID required – e.g. Family Pass)
- ▶ **Young Family Ticket:** For couples with children up to three years old (born in 2021, proof is required), the second person pays only the children's rate (this applies only to multi-day ski passes).
- ▶ **Family Days:** From 8 – 23 December 2023 and 18 March – 1 April 2024, children under 16 ski for free when accompanied by at least one parent. This applies only to multi-day ski passes for 2 days or more.

### Everybody loves "Kreisch"i"

"Kreischchi" is the Kreischberg's popular mascot. Children love to take him home right away, as the cuddly toy animal is available at the lift ticket office. You can even meet "Kreischchi" live at some events. For children, the Kreischberg is full of discoveries: dino forest, Kreischchi safari, Kreischchi cinema and even a fun Kreischchi ghost track can all be explored. The very little ones start at the baby lift or magic carpet and can make their first turns on the practice slope.

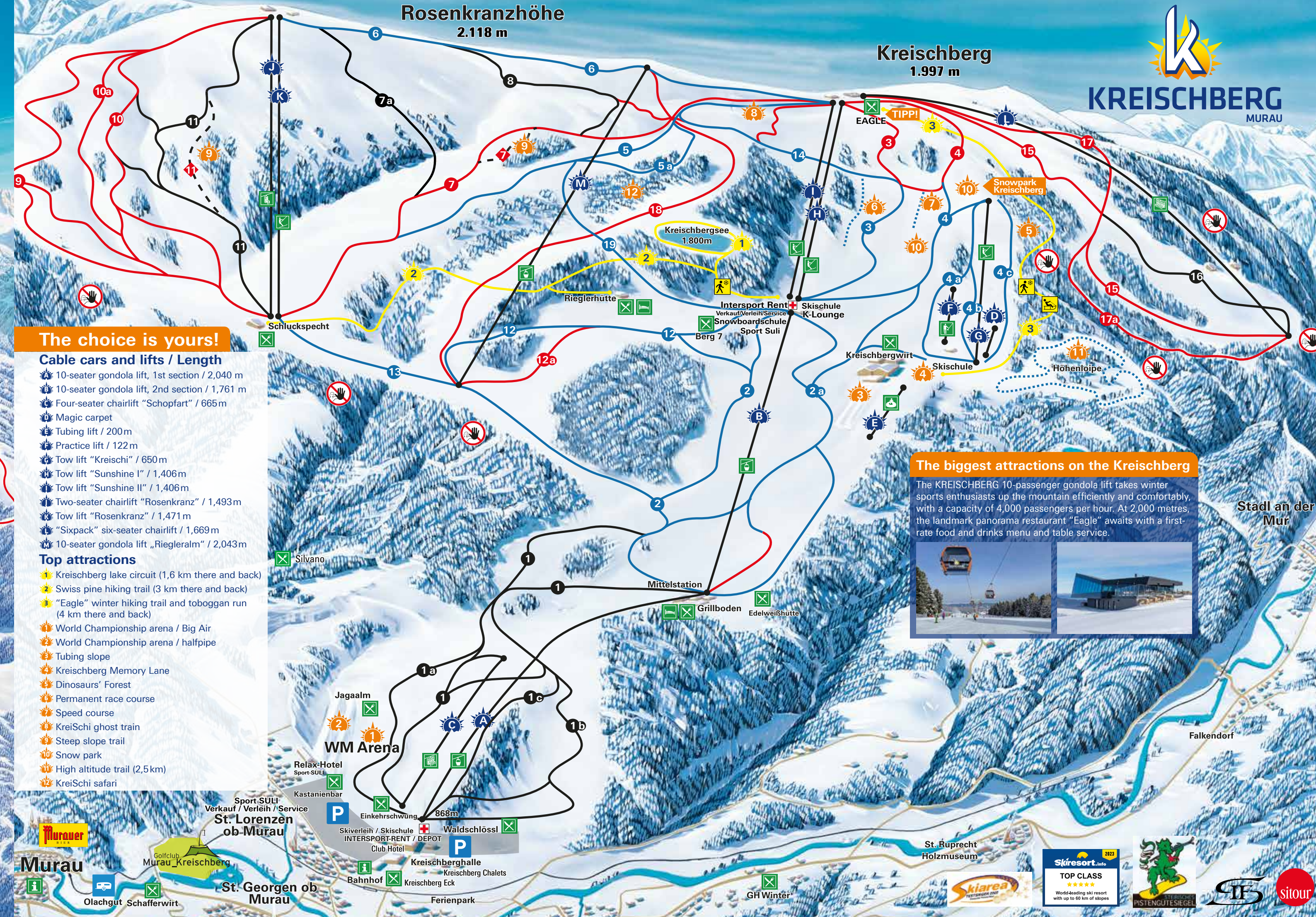
