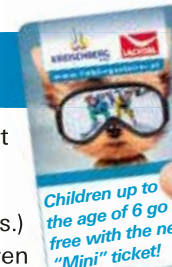

Family benefits

► **Family bonus:** When accompanied by at least one parent, only two children/young people (born in 2007 or later) pay. The other children ski for free. (Proof required – e.g. family ski pass.)

► **Young Family Ticket:** For couples with children up to three years old (born in 2023, proof is required), the second person pays only the children's rate (this applies only to multi-day ski passes).

► **Family Days:** From 5 – 24 December 2025 and 16 March – 6 April 2026, children under 16 ski for free when accompanied by at least one parent. This applies only to multi-day ski passes for 2 days or more.

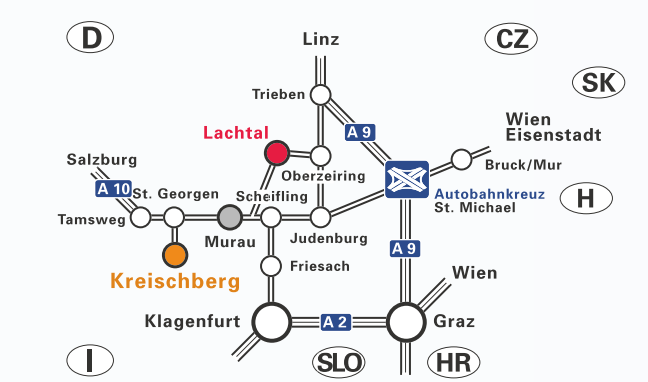

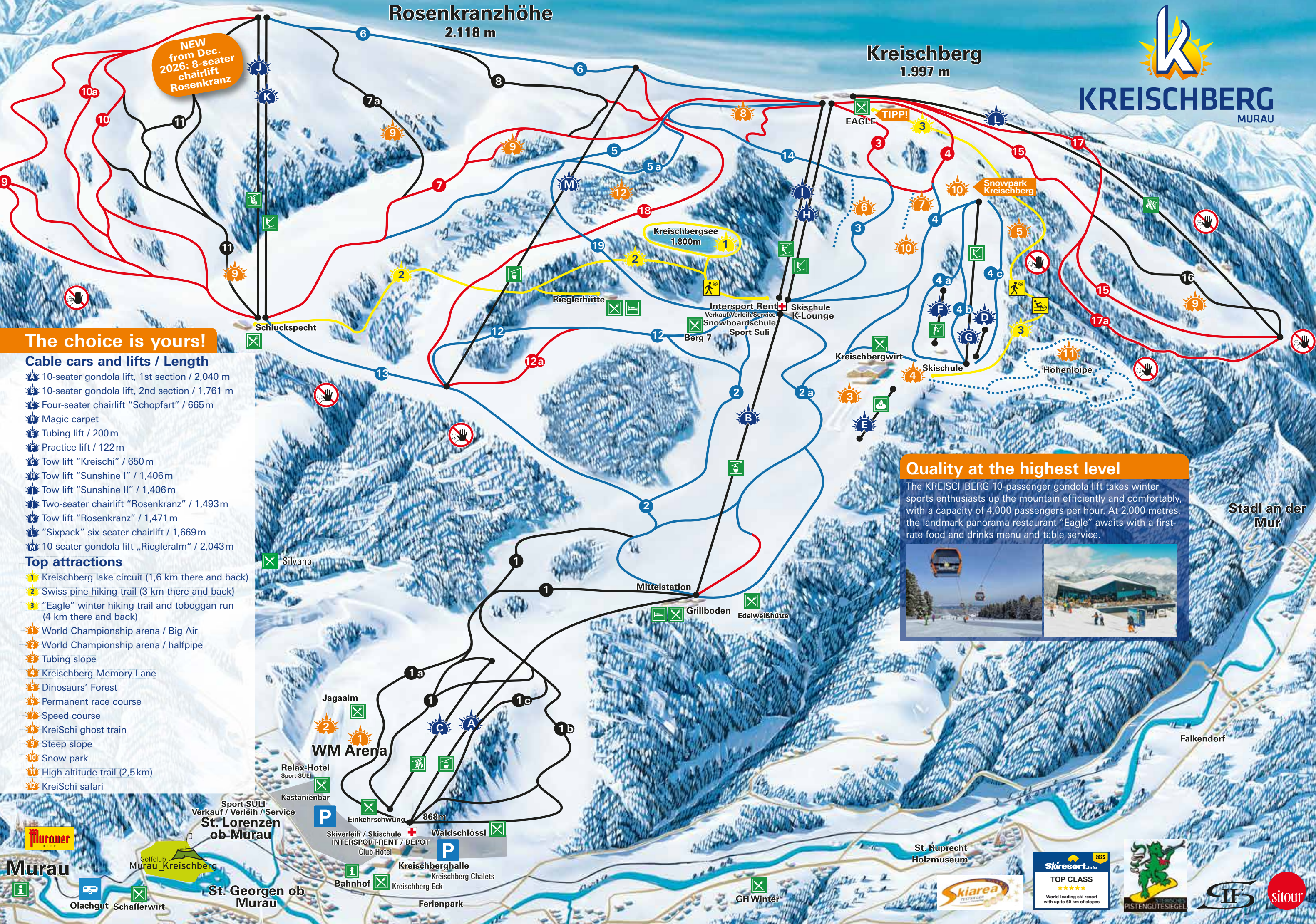
